Intensive German course

Within the framework of the political and economic globalization and due to the move towards the European unification process, knowledge of foreign languages is becoming increasingly important. Our intensive German course is directed at all those who seek to acquire, within a very short time, profound and proficient knowledge in German language for occupation or studies.

Our qualities

Maximum intensity

We give 30 lesson periods ("lesson hours") a week. Our intermediate course follows immediately after the basic course. In this way you can attain, within a short period, your desired standard in the language.

Pedagogical competence

Our tutors are all having a very solid philological education and many years of teaching experience in German as a foreign language. We teach in groups of 10 to 15 persons.

Individuality and mutuality or togetherness (community spirit)

Personal counsel and the daily practice of what is learnt within the communal spirit in our international student hostel are the hallmarks of our training concept.

Qualification

Our curriculum follows the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages" (CEF). After each stage you have the possibility to examine your level of competence through a final test. At the end of your stay you receive, for the tests passed, a certificate as a proof of your competence in the language.

Acknowledgment of Quality

Our language institute is directed and works according to the Quality Management System DIN EN ISO 9001:2008 standard, as officially certified by Moody International Certification, licence number 08193 dated 28th August 2009.

Intensive programme

The beginners courses (Standard A1-A2-B1 CEF)

Basic level I	8 – 9 weeks
Basic level II	8 – 9 weeks
Basic level III	4 weeks

You learn the basics for daily conversation and also develop basic vocabulary. Even long discussions could then be followed. You can also read and compose easy texts. You also learn, in addition, basic grammar and orthography.

The follow-up courses (Standard B2 CEF)

Intermediate level I	4 weeks
Intermediate level II	4 weeks
Intermediate level III	4 weeks

You are then in a position to participate in discussions and to present your opinion. You could even be in a position to give an oral or written report on topics relating to your field of studies. The required grammar and vocabulary would be taught at length. You could also grasp the central idea in complex texts, whether spoken or written, from business, politics and culture.

The special courses (Standard C 1.1 CEF)

University preparation course (DSH-course)

In this course you are directly prepared for the required entrance exam for your field of studies in the university. By treating specialist and technical texts and the core aspects of business language as well as the independent writing and presentation of reports you are then put in a position to actively participate in academic discussions and to be able to understand a lecture.

TestDaF

The preparation for the TestDaF forms the content and the techniques used in this course. The course programme is pre-determined by the demands of this globally recognised test (reading comprehension, listening comprehension, oral and written expression). As the Kreuzberg Bonn e.V. is a local test centre officially licensed by the TestDaF Institute, the test can be passed in our premises.

International student hostel

Our international students boarding house is available to a limited number of students. It has single rooms and two-bed rooms and full board is provided. Wireless internet facility is available in the whole house and also some LAN cable connections. Such rooms are at the disposal of students for purposes relating to studies, leisure time or recreation. The parkland of our house invites one to take a walk and to also undertake sport activities like table tennis, volleyball, football etc.

Since our students house is close to the central area, students have the possibility to participate in the extensive cultural life of the city of Bonn (concerts, Beethoven-Music Programme, Festivals, Theatre, Opera, Museum etc.)

The teaching period

The intensive course takes place **Monday to Friday from 8:00 to 13:15 hours or from 13:15 to 18:15 hours** (that means 6 lesson periods a day). Due to administrative reasons a change of the teaching period from morning to afternoon and vice versa could be necessary. Participants with background knowledge are requested to take a short placement test at the beginning of the course.

Costs

4 weeks intensive course: € 460.00 (€ 3.83 per lesson period)
for students (18-25 years) € 410.00 (€ 3.42 per lesson period)
